HOW BIG CAN MY DINING TABLE BE COMPARED WITH THE SIZE OF THE ROOM?

- The maximum size for a dining table – without being physically too large or overwhelming the space – scales with the total size of your dining room, as well as the shape of the table
- The table is a central element of the room, and can generally take up as much as a third of the total floor space
- Each side of the table should have at least 3 feet of clearance, for pulling out chairs and walking around the table
- If you need some versatility to accommodate larger numbers of people occasionally, an extendable table or one with folding leaves can provide the space you need at a moments notice.
- Round tables are often the best choice for smaller spaces, as they're more compact and easier to walk around.
- Each person at the table should have about two feet of space per person to comfortably sit and engage
